
# <u>Masākāēw Trail Bike Route</u>

Masākāēw Trail is a family-friendly bike route from Rotary Park in the City of Waupaca to the Tomorrow River Trail at Ogdensburg to Scandinavia and back to the City of Waupaca past Swan Park and then to Rotary Park again. This trail name is a Menominee word for "crossing over water" which it does ten times. We named it this to acknowledge the original land of the Menominee through which the trail runs. This route can be ridden in pieces for younger or less hardy riders.

## Masākāēw is pronounced Ma'-sa-ca ['a' as in 'cat']

## Beginning at Rotary Riverview Park (Waupaca, WI)

- A. Head north from parking lot, turn Right on Water St.
- B. Water St. Becomes Mill St./ Follow Mill St.
- C. Left on Oak St.
- D. Right on Redfield/Townsend Rd.
- E. Right on County Rd. E
- F. Left on Nichols Creek Rd.
- G. Left on Ebbe Lake Rd.
- H. Right on East Ware Rd.
- I. East Ware Rd. merges with Granite Quarry Road & Waupaca Rd.
- J. Continue north on East Ware Rd./Granite Quarry Rd./Waupaca Rd.
- K. When you reach Ogdensburg, turn Right on Main St.
- L. Immediate Left on Humbolt St. and follow to Tomorrow River Trail
- M. Left and take the Tomorrow River Trail (West)
- N. Left on Gurholt Rd. (Outside of Scandinavia)
- O. Follow Gurholt Rd./Peterson Rd.
- P. Right on County Rd. Q
- Q. Left on Smokey Valley Rd.
- R. Right on Oakland Dr.
- S. Left onto Larson
- T. Right on Brainerd Dr.
- U. Left on Timber Dr.
- V. Right on N. Harrison St.
- W. Immediate left onto Elm St.
- X. Right onto Mill St./Water St., Follow Water St.
- Y. Left into Rotary Riverview Park.
